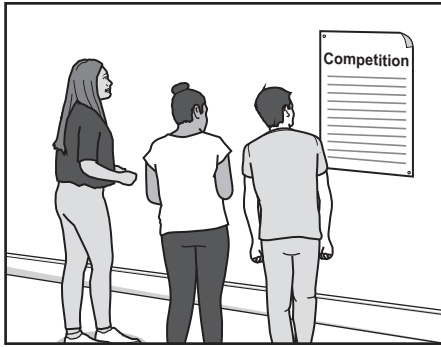


Exercise 5
